Portugal submitted two national reports concerning ST A and ST D. These reports were prepared by members of the national road authority and of a technical university.

The "Call for individual papers and PIARC prizes" for the 2011 World Road Congress was translated into Portuguese and disseminated.

The Portuguese National Committee will be present in the poster session to be displayed in the PIARC pavilion: the poster presents some data of the Portuguese road sector and highlights PNC activities.

The XXIV<sup>th</sup> Congress was promoted in the PNC website and InIR, IP website and also near road concessionary companies and relevant Portuguese road institutions.

Following the request made by the General Secretary, a text promoting the Congress was published in two Portuguese newspapers with large print runs and focused on technical, economic and financial issues.

<p>One of the main goals of the PNC is to promote and disseminate PIARC's goals and products and technical documentation among Portuguese-speaking African countries and East Timor.</p> <p>The Portuguese version of the International Road Maintenance Handbook was distributed on a large scale to representatives of national roads organizations of Mozambique (<i>Administração Nacional de Estradas</i> and <i>Fundo de Estradas</i>).</p> <p>The same document was also distributed to a Portuguese organization that is in charge of the management of forestry roads.</p> <p>The PIARC activities have been also promoted through the Portuguese National Committee website and through special activities conducted from time to time, usually related with Portuguese versions of PIARC technical reports.</p>
