RAPPORT DÉTAILLÉ SUR DES POINTS CULMINANTS

DETAILED REPORT ON HIGHLIGHTS

Highlights of the year had been an increasing membership and a gradual revitalisation of the WRA UK. IT is of particular pleasure that Transport for Llondon are now members of the organisation and were represented on the Technical Committees. There had been a very high number of applications to represent the UK on the WRA Technical Committees and places were oversubscribed. In total, the UK had 28 representatives.

The Paris Congress had been successful and there had been much positive feedback. With a UK presence of over 90 individuals attending.

This year, a joint IHT/TRL/WRA UK Conference would be held on 2nd October. The topic would be climate change.

The WRA UK was also planning a to give a series of presentations to the IHT UK Branches over the next year to further share the learning and knowledge of the organisation. The aim of the Roadshow was to inform the IHT UK Branches about the work of the WRA. Branches had been offered the opportunity to invite speakers from the WRA UK to present at their branch meetings. Two presentations would be given, a generic one and a technical one, focusing on the work of one of the technical committees.

Links with IHT were being strengthened with joint meetings now held between the WRA UK Technical Representatives and the IHT Technical Board Chairs and Vice Chairs.

At the AGM in June voting took place to elect a Vice Chair of the WRA UK Executive Committee and also to elect Ordinary Members of the Committee. The results were as follows:
