26th March, 2014, at the headquarters of the Argentinian Road Association, intended for highways emergency services and public sector will discuss the webinar presentation of the International Road Federation (IRF) and presentations of the Office for Control of Highway Concession and National Highways.

UNRA became operational on 1st July 2008.The mandate of UNRA is to develop and maintain the national roads network, advise Government on general roads policy and contribute to addressing of transport concerns, among others.
