Japan was represented by about 100 delegates including road administrators, engineers from both public and private sectors, and members of the academia. We also set up a national stand in collaboration with the Hokkaido Development Agency to display our winter maintenance technology as well as the environment and safety challenges.

Japan intends to participate in the Congress and will have a national stand at its exhibition. The Japanese topic of the exhibition will be "The Economic Development by the Honshu-Shikoku Bridges."
