Poster sessions will be organised during the PIARC seminar “INTERNATIONAL SEMINAR on Integrated Road Transport and Mobility” organised by the TCs B1, B3 and B4 in Cape Town, South Africa, on November 5-7, 2018. Researchers and end users are strongly encouraged to take this opportunity to present their research works and case studies in an International seminar on the most recent developments in active areas of passenger and freight mobility.

Poster proposals are welcome and authors are invited to submit an electronic poster using the proposed template by June 30, 2018.

Posters will be displayed during the seminar in a hall of the venue, and the poster sessions will be active during the coffee breaks to facilitate discussions between the authors and the participants.

The presenters of accepted posters must register to the seminar and will get a reduced registration fee.

Poster proposals will be reviewed by the Program Committee of the seminar, and the acceptance and comments will be notified to the first author by August 31st 2018.

## GUIDELINES FOR POSTER SUBMISSION

- Poster proposal submission by June 30 is mandatory to get a poster accepted.
- A short bio of the first author/presenter (max. 100 words) shall be submitted with the poster proposal. It shall contain the main author's position, department or service (if applicable), address, city, state or province (if applicable), zip code, country, phone and email.
- All posters must be submitted in the mandatory template.

- Posters must be submitted in English only.
- The evaluation criteria will be: (1) compliance to the seminar topics, (2) originality of the work, (3) added knowledge beyond the state-of-the-art and usefulness for practitioners, (4) clarity and quality of the presentation (incl. language), and (5) commercial free content.
- After acceptance notification, authors must print out their posters in A0 format (1189mm x 841mm: height x width) vertical and deliver them on site Monday Nov. 5 by 1:00 pm. Display boards and materials to fix the posters will be provided by the organizers.
- Posters must contain all author's names, first names or initials, affiliations, cities and countries, and at least the email of the corresponding/main author.
