

## Reclaimed Asphalt



- Wearing course ≤ 20 %.
- Base course ≤ 30 %.
- SMA = 0 %.
- Size ≤ 1.4D. ???

#### Recovered bitumen



- Penetration ≥ 25 (30)
- Ring & Ball ≤ 65 (60)
- Tar = 0

## Homogenity

- Grading of RA
- binder's softening point
- binder's penetration


## Mix design

- Average RA sample is used
- Recovered binder is renewed

#### Problems

- Variable moisture content
- Thermal problems on sieves
- Limited use of rejunovators
- "Greasing "of dry filters"

#### Conclusions

- RA can be recycled in a batch plant up to 25 %
- RA shall be crushed, sieved and sorted
- Successful use requires right preparation and storage of RA
- Certain additional laboratory work is needed for controlled and height quality production
