GENERAL INFORMATION OF VIET NAM – HA NOI

Geography



The Socialist Republic of Viet Nam, a sovereign and reunified independent country, has a high percentage of territorial waters. Looking at the map, Viet Nam is located in the center of the Southeast Asia, and is shaped like the letter "S". The country lies in the eastern part of the Indochina peninsula, bordered by China to the north, Laos and Cambodia to the west, and the East Sea and Pacific Ocean to the southeast. Viet Nam's coast line is 3,260 km long. Viet Nam is also a transport junction from the Indian Ocean to the Pacific Ocean.



The Capital, the historical, the evergreen city of Ha Noi.

Ha Noi with the population of 4,100,000 (2004), is the capital of Viet Nam and located on the right bank of the Red River. Ha Noi is located at 21°2' North, 105°51' East (21.0333, 105.85). Ha Noi still preserves many ancient architectural works including the Old Quarter and over 600 pagodas. Hectares of lakes lie intertwined between the streets, the largest ones being Hoan Kiem Lake, West Lake, and Truc Bach Lake. Many traditional handicrafts are also practiced in Ha Noi including bronze molding, silver carving, lacquer, embroidery, machine tools, plywood, textiles and chemicals.

Climate

Viet Nam is located in both a tropical and a temperate zone. It is characterized by strong monsoon influences, but has a considerable amount of sun, a high rate of rainfall, and high humidity. Regions located near the tropics and in the mountainous regions are endowed with a temperate climate. The annual average temperature ranges from 22C to 27C. In <u>Ha Noi</u>, the average temperature is 23C, in <u>Ho Chi Minh City</u> it is 26C, and in Hue it is 25C.

There are two distinguishable seasons. The cold season occurs from November to April and the hot season from May to October. The difference in temperature between the two seasons in southern Viet Nam is almost unnoticeable, averaging 3C. The most noticeable variations are found in the northern provinces where differences of 12C have been observed. There are essentially four distinct seasons, which are most evident in the northern provinces. Winter (Nov-Feb) is generally cool and dry, with temperatures between 10-15°C (59-68°F). Spring (Feb-Apr) is warmer, but accompanied by constant drizzle which can start to wear a bit. Summer (May-Sep) is blatantly hot (30-36°C; 86-97°F) and sticky with the occasional devastating typhoon. Autumn (Sep-Nov) however, sees sunny, often perfect weather.
