Climate, Territory and Infrastructures: Managing Risk, Building Resilience

Portugal has been increasingly facing the impacts of climate change in a more visible and significant way. Portugal has increasingly been facing the impacts of climate change, reflected in greater exposure of its territory and critical infrastructure to extreme events. The storms recorded at the beginning of this year highlight this vulnerability, posing new challenges for the protection, management, and adaptation of infrastructure.

In this context, CRP – the Portuguese Road and Rail Platform – and PIARC – the World Road Association are organizing the workshop “Climate, Territory and Infrastructure: Managing Risk, Building Resilience”, under the coordination of APA – the Portuguese Environment Agency, which leads the Environment Working Group within CRP. This initiative aims to foster structured discussion among decision-makers and stakeholders from the infrastructure and construction sectors in Portugal.

For the morning roundtable sessions, the presence has already been confirmed of the Mayor of Leiria, Gonçalo Lopes, the Mayor of Ourém, Luís Miguel Albuquerque, and the Mayor of Pombal, Pedro Pimpão. The participation of the President of PIARC, Emanuela Stocchi, as well as the President of IMT, João Jesus Caetano, has also been confirmed.

The programme is currently being consolidated and is expected to include contributions from distinguished figures, within the framework of a national commitment to climate change adaptation and the safeguarding of critical infrastructure.
