The Barra Vieja Bridge is located in Lomas de Chapultepec, south of Acapulco, at the mouth of the Papagayo River, in the state of Guerrero, Mexico.

The projected structure is a concrete sail bridge with a 220 m main span. The total length of the bridge is 470 m, with 5 spans of 30, 40, 90, 90, 220 and 90 m. The structure was designed without piers in the main channel due to possible sand liquefaction phenomena under seismic action, which is very high in this area, also avoiding scour in large floods.


